The Trustees along with Trust Secretary Dean and Trust Treasurer Wendy have been relatively busy since the 2012 National AGM held in Hamilton, Ontario last fall. As you may well recall a \$35,000.00 cheque on behalf of the AFAC membership was presented to the Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum at that time.

A grant of \$1500.00 was approved by the Trustees for “Operation Freedom Trail 2013” in late November 2012. Trustees then approved a \$2,000.00 “kick off” grant to the Yellow Wings Project.

Shortly thereafter the Trust Fund received a \$19,000.00 cheque from the close out funds of the 407 (Demon) Squadron Association, thanks to the involvement of AFAC National President Terry Chester.

Trustees then agreed to donate another \$12,500.00 to the Yellow Wings Project. AFACs goal in conjunction with the RCAF

Association Trust fund is to fund up to 100 cadets or \$37,500.00. At this time I believe that we are close to half way there. It is strongly encouraged that AFAC Wings will seriously consider taking up the challenge to sponsor one ride for one cadet at a cost of \$375.00.
