- 8 The Chairman reported that during FY 95/96 the Trust disbursed \$19,862.00 in designated donations and \$1,350.00 from discretionary funds.

- 9. The Chairman reported that the Capital Investment of the Air Cadet 50th Anniversary Trust Fund of the RCAF Association, is now \$75,000.00. In FY 95/96 \$10,000.00 of designated donations were added to the Capital Investment and \$1,923.00 were used to augment the 1995 Continuation Flying Training Awards (CFTA). 110 CFTA have been presented to deserving Air Cadets across Canada since 1991 and funds are available for 23 Association awards in 1996.
- 10. Trustees were briefed on a proposal from 600 Wing, Regina, which currently comprises a \$500.00 donation held "in trust" within the Trust. Accordingly, the Trust minimum balance will be retained at \$20,500.00.

Best wishes for 1996 . Herewith an update on MAJA Inust activities since our last meeting , in Edmonton , 06 October , 1995.

Perignated donations to the Air (adet 50th Anniversary Inust Jund of the RCAI Association (Continuation Flying Inairing Awards) continue to dominate Inust activities. Puring the period OI ful 95 to 31 Dec 95 \$10,423.00 in designated donations were passed to the Air (adet League. Our capital investment has been established at \$75,000.00 and 110 (IIA have been distributed to deserving Air (adets across (anada, since 1991. We require interest of \$6,000.00 annually to provide 20 x \$300.00 awards.

Since 01 Jun 96, an additional three donations (in memory of Gulla Baldwin, P. Pe Smedt, and 428 Wing Peterborough) in the amount of \$1,350.00 have been designated to the CIIA program.

Jo Pate, \$1,300.00 (three donations) have been designated to the Halifax Aircraft Association restoration program at the R(AI Memorial Museum at Irenton. A designated donation of \$339.00 (from Allison and Hayward) went to the BCAIP Museum in Brandon, and \$300.00 went to two designated Air (adet Squadrons in Wirripeq.

We (trustees) approved three grants in October. The MVA grant of \$300.00 was actioned by our Immediate Past National President at the MVA arrual meeting.

The \$100.00 quant to renew our Associate membership in the Normandy Found'n was actioned in early Jan 96. The \$300.00 quant to the RAI Memorial Museum has not been disbursed and awaits completion of the AFPL regulia inventory account.

In summary, to date, in H 95/96 the RCATA Inust has disbursed § 13, 712.00 in designated donations and \$400.00 in approved grants. One approved grant of \$300.00 remains a liability.

As al 15 Jan 96 , we have 3623.00 available for trustee consideration and 9 suggest we can disburse \$650.000 and still remain above the directed balance of \$20,000.00 .

You may recall that there was a subjectation package available for each delegate, in Edmonton, on behalf of the Allied Hin Jonces Memorial, Jonkshine Air Museum— (anada Branch in support of the Caradian Memorial Hangar Jund. . 9 have been contacted by several of the Patrions — Distinguished NAI members all, and solicit your support for a donation from the NAIA Just to this very worthy cause. Options include a \$50.00 aroual membership fee on a one time donation of \$350.00 for life membership. I propose the latter to avoid any ongoing commitment. This donation has been made possible by individual donations from two trustees and one member-at-lange. Subject to your approval we will have a further \$300.00 resulting from accumulated interest.

My choice would be a \$300.00 grant to the Halifax restonation Jund . Once again, I request your comments on these proposals to facilitate appropriate action . I will relay trustee comments before taking further action .

AUDITORS' REPORT

To the Trustees of Royal Canadian Air Force Association Trust

We have audited the statement of financial position of Royal Canadian Air Force Association Trust as at June 30, 1996 and the summary of transactions and balance of trust for the year then ended. This financial statement is the responsibility of the Trust's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on this financial statement based on our audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, we conducted our audit in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test hasis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

In common with many charitable organizations, the Trust derives revenue from contributions the completeness of which is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of this revenue was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of the Trust and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contributions revenue, assets and balance of trust.

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves concerning the completeness of the contributions referred to in the preceding paragraph, this financial statement presents fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Trust as at June 30, 1996 and the results of its operations for the year then ended in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.
