#### **AUDITORS' REPORT**

To the Trustees of Royal Canadian Air Force Association Trust

We have audited the balance sheet of the Royal Canadian Air Force Association Trust as at June 30, 2004 and the summary of receipts and disbursements for the year then ended. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Trust's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

Except as explained in the following paragraph, we conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Those standards require that we plan and perform an audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether these financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall financial statement presentation.

In common with many charitable organizations, the Trust derives revenue from contributions, the completeness of which is not susceptible of satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of this revenue was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of the Trust and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to contribution receipts, assets and balance of trust equity.

In our opinion, except for the effect of adjustments, if any, which we might have determined to be necessary had we been able to satisfy ourselves concerning the completeness of the contribution receipts referred to in the preceding paragraph, these financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the Trust as at June 30, 2004 and the results of its operations for the year then ended in accordance with Canadian generally accepted accounting principles. As required by the Canada Corporations Act, we report that, in our opinion, these principles have been applied on a basis consistent with that of the preceding year.



#### NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

JUNE 30, 2004

#### 1. PURPOSE OF TRUST

The Trust is a subsidiary of the Air Force Association of Canada, created in accordance with the Trust Agreement, that is responsible for raising and distributing funds at the National Level for the Association charitable programs. The Trust is a registered charitable organization.

#### 2. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### (a) Basis of Accounting

Receipts and disbursements are recorded on the accrual basis, whereby they are reflected in the accounts in the period in which they have been earned and incurred respectively, whether or not such transactions have been finally settled by the receipt or payment of money.

#### (b) Volunteer Services

Volunteers assist the Trust in carrying out its service delivery activities. Due to the difficulty of determining their fair value, volunteer services are not recognized in the financial statements.

#### 3. FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS

The Trust's financial instruments consist of cash, short-term investments, accounts receivable, accrued interest receivable and accounts payable and accrued liabilities. Unless otherwise noted, it is management's opinion that the Trust is not exposed to significant interest rate or credit risk arising from these financial instruments.

#### Fair Value

The carrying amounts reported in the balance sheet for these financial instruments approximate fair values due to their immediate or short-term maturities.

#### 4. SHORT-TERM INVESTMENTS

Short-term investments are recorded at cost, which equals market value.

#### 5. RELATED PARTIES

Royal Canadian Air Force Association Trust and Air Force Productions Limited are subsidiaries of the Air Force Association of Canada. All entities share office space and administrative services.

During the year, the Trust disbursed grants of \$35 to Air Force Productions Limited and \$100 to Air Force Association of Canada. These transactions were measured at the exchange amount, which was the amount of consideration established and agreed to by the related parties.
